Match Format

The match will be a Tournament level match. Scores will be posted on the Match Web Site (www.uspsa-area6.org) at the end of each day. Final match results will be posted on the Match web page, as well as on the USPSA web site (www.uspsa.org).

Squadding Information

You will have a choice on a **first come, first serve (by postmark)** basis of squadding times. There is a place to indicate your 1st, 2nd, and 3rd squadding time choices on the entry form. You can choose to shoot the match all in one day on Friday, all in one day on Saturday, or split the match over two days and shoot Saturday Morning / Sunday Morning, or Saturday Afternoon / Sunday Morning.

We will still use on-line squadding to allow shooters to adjust their squadding.

We will fill any squad requests you submit with your application if we can do so at the time we enter your registration data into the system. This means we will put you directly in an all day Saturday slot if you ask and we have one open, and will even put you into squads with people you request. Please see the note about 'Waitlisting' below.

Once we enter your registration data on-line, your initial squadding data will be available and you may change it using the web based system.

There are a few limitations to this system:

Limitation #1: We will not re-arrange existing squads. If you ask to be squadded with Bill and Bob, and they are already in different squads, we will not move one of them to fit you three together. You, Bill and Bob are, however, welcome to do that yourself with the on-line squadding system.

Limitation #2: We will not "hold openings" in slots for future arrivals. Requests such as "save an opening in this squad and put Joe in it if he signs up" will not be tracked.

Limitation #3: We will not track "forward looking requests" which cannot be processed at the time we are entering your registration data. These are requests like "squad me with Joe Blow who is signing in his registration separately".

Limitation #4: If a shooter has requested a "private registration", they do not exist on the squadding matrix when processing competitor requests. If you ask to be squadded with Ms. Famous, and Ms. Famous has requested her name be kept off the public registration list, don't expect us to squad you with her unless Ms. Famous has given us permission to honor this request.

Waitlisting

If your choice does not exist at the time we receive your entry **and you have indicated to place you on the waitlist**, we will put you in your second choice of squadding times and place you on the waitlist for your 1st choice. Waitlisting will be done by postmark. We will attempt to notify you by email, so please make sure that is included on your application. If your entry clears the waitlist, **we cannot guarantee that we can place you in a particular squad or with your buddies, so please be sure you want to be waitlisted for a session.**

Some all day Saturday slots will be reserved for those people volunteering to be Friday ROs but will be released to the waiting list on 3/15/09.

Awards/Prizes

All class and category winners, as well as division winners, will receive a plaque. Awards of prizes will be made in the 6 Divisions (Open, Limited, L10, Production, Revolver and Single Stack) as listed in the match booklet. The total amount of prizes for each division will be based upon the number of competitors in that division.

You or your designee will need to be present to visit the prize table when your name is called. A competitor may receive all trophies, which he or she merits, however a competitor is entitled to only one (1) trip to the prize table.

A division must have at least 5 competitors for recognition. A category must have at least 3 or more competitors for recognition.

Match Host Hotels

In the Conyers area off of I-20 East we have three hotels with discounted rooms for our match. Please call the hotels directly for the discounted rates. The Hampton Inn (770-483-8838) has queen rooms for \$79 and kings for a small additional amount. Please use the code 'Area 6' to get the discounted rate for the Hampton. The block of rooms for the Hampton will be released on 3/31/09. The brand new Holiday Inn Express (678-964-2400) is on the I-20 access road at the same exit (GA Hwy 20/HWY 138) and is an all suite hotel with a rate for us of \$95 per night. Please use the code 'AREA6GPL' for the HIE.

One exit west is the recently remodeled Ramada Inn & Conference Center (770-483-3220). Their rate is \$79 per night with a full hot breakfast buffet. You will need to ask for the South River Gun Club rate. All hotels are approximately 15 miles from the range. Other hotels in the area will be about the same distance from the range and there are good restaurants nearby.

We have one hotel in McDonough that is a favorite of some of our folks that come up from I-75 South. The Best Inn (770-957-5821) has inexpensive rooms but has not agreed to give us any discounts. Their rate is very inexpensive. There are some good restaurants nearby, but not as many as in Conyers. It is about the same distance from the range as Conyers.

2009 Area 6 ROs & Staff

The 2009 Area 6 Championship Match needs the help of volunteers who will donate their time, skills and effort to make the match fair, safe and fun for the shooters.

Same as last year! Each RO/CRO will receive a per diem of \$50 for each full day and \$25 for each half day worked during the Area 6. (Sunday counts as a full day for any staff staying through tear down) This can be used for paying your hotel room and for buying your lunch on match days. I need to limit the amount of ROs and CROs that I can pay a per diem for budget purposes, so please sign up early!

We would like to offer an opportunity to any RO or CRO who would be willing to work Friday, then shoot the match on Saturday and Sunday with a squad. **We will hold a few Saturday only slots for our Friday ROs until 03/15/09.** Friday only staff will pay \$75 for the entry fee for the match. Staff shooters are eligible for all the prizes and awards available to any other competitor. **Friday ROs will receive a free match T-shirt or hat if you sign up to work by March 15th.** Water and soft drinks will be available to you in the staff trailer during the match.
